

# AMERICAN BAPTIST MEN OF NEBRASKA

**SEMINARY SCHOLARSHIPS:** ABMNE presents scholarships for students attending seminary. Program guidelines:

## **I. Academic**

a. Student must be eligible for enrollment in an accredited seminary

## **II. Statements from applicant**

- a. There shall be evidence of Christian experience and personal faith.
- b. There shall be a statement or evidence of educational plans and goals.
- c. There shall be a statement providing evidence of participation and leadership in applicant's local church.
- d. There shall be a statement of call to ministry and career plans.

## **III. References**

- a. The applicant shall receive permission from three references and one of these will be a pastor. The applicant will supply the names and addresses of these three references on the application.
- b. The letters of reference should include the following.
  - 1. Perception of applicant's leadership ability.
  - 2. Commitment to ministry.
  - 3. Commitment to educational preparation.

## **IV. Funds will be issued to the seminary for distribution.**

## **V. Preferential sequence for granting seminary scholarship.**

- a. Nebraska Baptist student to Central Seminary.
- b. Nebraska Baptist student to any ABC seminary.
- c. Nebraska Baptist student to any other accredited seminary.
- d. Student from outside Nebraska to Central Seminary.
